1. **Author's Retention of Rights.** Author(s) and Publisher agree that, notwithstanding any terms in the Publication Agreement to the contrary, and in addition to any rights under copyright retained by Author in the Publication Agreement, Author(s) retain(s) the right to:

- (i) Deposit a machine-readable electronic copy of the published version or the final manuscript (after peer-review) in the institutional repository at the time of publication.
- (ii) Provide open access (i.e. free of charge access to the electronic copy to anyone) through the EPFL institutional repository at the latest within 6 months after publication (12 months for publications in the social sciences and humanities).
- (iii) To use, reproduce, distribute, create derivative works including update, perform and display publicly, the final manuscript in electronic, digital or print form in connection with the Authors' teaching, conference presentations, lectures, other scholarly works, and for all Authors' academic and professional activities for any non-commercial purposes without requesting explicit authorization from the publisher.

To authorize others to make any non-commercial use of the work as long as Authors receive credit and the journal in which the work has been published is cited as the source of first publication without requesting explicit authorization from the publisher.

- 2. The parties agree that wherever there is any conflict between this Amendment and the Publisher's Publication Agreement, the provisions of this Amendment are paramount, and the Publication Agreement shall be construed accordingly.
- 3. For record keeping purposes, Author request that Publisher sign a copy of this Amendment and return it to Author. However, if the publisher publishes the article in the journal or in any other form without signing a copy of this Amendment, such publication manifests the publisher's assent to the terms of this Amendment.
- 4. All other provisions of the Publishing Agreement remain unchanged
